## WESTERN EUROPEAN STUDIES MINOR

I. Foreign Language: Demonstrate proficiency in a Western European language at a level equivalent to the completion of five semester of study at the university level. The fifth semester course must be a course in which the language is used to study the history, literature, politics, or culture of the related country, rather than a course that involves only grammar or composition. The results of the MSU foreign language placement test will be considered in determining whether or not the student has fulfilled this requirement.
