Muslim Studies Minor Program:

I. Foreign Language: [Arabic, Persian, Turkish, Urdu, Bahasa Indonesia, Malay, or Swahili] 2 years or approved substitution

II. Five courses with Muslim studies or Islamic content selected from two different categories, with at least one from each category. Not more than one IAH or ISS course may count toward the five required courses. Students must contact the Muslim Studies minor coordinator for an update list of approved courses prior to enrollment.
