

WESTERN EUROPEAN STUDIES MINOR

Below is a checklist for students in the Western European Studies minor who began at MSU Fall 2014 or after. It may help students visualize how the various parts of the curriculum fit together.

I. **Foreign Language:** Demonstrate proficiency in a Western European language at a level equivalent to the completion of five semester of study at the university level. The fifth semester course must be a course in which the language is used to study the history, literature, politics, or culture of the related country, rather than a course that involves only grammar or composition. The results of the MSU foreign language placement test will be considered in determining whether or not the student has fulfilled this requirement.

II. **Social Science:** At least *three* courses totaling at least *9 credits* selected from at least *two* of the following groups of courses:
